



Small Business is one of the few Trusted Institutions in America




Trust in Small Business is 5 times higher than Big Business



Polarization: Growing Shares of both Republicans & Democrats say members of the other party are more immoral, dishonest, close-minded than other Americans


% who say members of the **other** party are a lot/somewhat more ____ compared to other Americans

Our Youth's META Dynamic CRISIS:

MENTAL HEALTH

- 44% of high school students feel "persistently sad or hopeless"
- 37% report poor mental health
- 22% seriously considered suicide
- 70% report anxiety and depression as major problems
- 61% report frequent loneliness
- 73% spend less time in face-to-face interaction than online

TRUST & DEMOCRACY COLLAPSE

- Only 7% of young people have "great deal" of trust in government
- 74% believe democracy is "in trouble" or "failing"
- 52% feel "politics has become too divisive to solve problems"

56% feel "American dream is no longer attainable"

ECONOMIC ANXIETY

- 63% of millennials living paycheck to paycheck
- Average student debt: \$37,000
- 48% can't afford home ownership
- 70% report financial stress affecting mental health
- 72% believe they'll be worse off than their parents

FUTURE CONCERNS

- 68% worry about climate change impacts
- 65% fear social/political instability
- 58% doubt they'll achieve retirement security
- 49% report having three or fewer close friends
- 39% feel they have "no one to talk to"




How Distrust & Polarization Destroy Civilization

- 1. DISTRUST & POLARIZATION have a bidirectional, mutually reinforcing relationship:
 - Distrust fuels polarization by making people less willing to engage with or understand those who hold different views
 - Polarization increases distrust by reducing meaningful contact between groups, amplifying negative perceptions of others

2. Key Mechanisms:

- When people Distrust other groups, they're more likely to:
 - · View opposing perspectives with suspicion
 - Attribute malicious motives to others' actions
 - Reject information from any distrusted group
 - Seek individuals & information confirms existing beliefs
- As Polarization Increases:
 - Fewer positive interactions across tribal boundaries
 - Echo chambers and information bubbles strengthen
 - Stereotypes and negative assumptions about other groups harden
 - Compromise becomes more difficult as positions become more extreme

Destructive Meta-Dynamic Force Field Matrix



1. Higher-Order Corruption:

- It doesn't just damage relationships; it damages our ability to repair relationships
- It doesn't just create disagreement; it destroys the tools we use to resolve disagreements
- It doesn't just separate people; it makes separation feel necessary and right

2. System-Wide Infection:

- Corrupts information flow (Can't trust their news/facts)
- Poisons dialogue (Why even talk to them?)
- Warps perception (They must be evil/stupid to believe that)
- Destroys common ground (We have nothing in common with them)

3. Self-Reinforcing Amplification:

- Each instance of distrust creates more polarization
- Each increase in polarization justifies more distrust
- The cycle accelerates as social bonds weaken
- The damage compounds exponentially

4. Institutional Breakdown:

- Undermines shared institutions
- Corrupts conflict resolution mechanisms
- Weakens social immune systems
- Makes reform seem impossible

5. Cognitive Rewiring:

- Changes how we process information
- Alters threat perception
- Reshapes group identity
- Modifies moral frameworks



Quest of the American Revolution

#1—Reason & Logic:

Using logical thinking and reasoning can lead you to the right and moral answer. Reason is the primary source of authority and legitimacy.

#2 - Divine Natural Order:

Human Behavior and Nature was not random nor irrational.

A strong moral/ethical character was borne into humans as part of Divine Order.

#3 – Progression of Civilization:

Each human being, together with civilization, should be on a steady trajectory of improvement embracing deep wisdom to make the next generation better than the last.

#4 -- Democratic Governance:

An enlightened society of responsible moral citizens for the people, by the people, and of the people, balancing individual rights with social obligation. Each Citizen had a duty to his fellow man.

#5 - Happiness & Well-Being:




These principles create a profound sense of well-being where people could trust their neighbors, trust their leaders, and trust in a vibrant world with constructive civil debate.




WASHINGTON's Meta-Dynamic Innovation: "Institutional Precedent Setting"


- . Created patterns for peaceful power transition
- Established non-partisan cabinet with diverse views (Hamilton/Jefferson)
- . Deliberately rejected monarchical trappings
- Set two-term precedent

Key Meta-Dynamic Effect:

- . Created sustainable patterns for democratic leadership
- Established principle that process > personality
- Built foundation for peaceful power transitions
 - Demonstrated how to unite former enemies (Federalists/Anti-Federalists)







Jefferson's Wisdom – Key Themes

- **Preserving Rights & Exercising Responsibilities**
- Constraining Tyrants & Protecting Against Abuses
- Primacy of Education to build Moral Character
- **Building Trust & Leadership in Local Institutions**
 - **Creating Communities that Cooperate**

Error of opinion may be tolerated where reason is left free to combat it.




Franklin Roosevelt's Wisdom – Key Themes

FDR's Marshall Plan to revitalize Germany & Japan exemplified a Constructive Meta-Dynamic Force Field

- Built democratic institutions from ground up

2. Democratic Institution Building:

- Supported free press development
- Built democratic education systems
- Developed democratic governance structures


3. Economic Integration Design:

4. Security Through Prosperity: Implementation Strategy:

- Development as stability creator, Growth as democracy builder




