Amy McGrath served over 20 years as a Marine Corps F/A-18 fighter pilot and weapons systems officer with three combat deployments in Iraq and Afghanistan. After her operational flying tours, she served as a Congressional Fellow working with the House Armed Services Committee. She was later assigned to the Pentagon as Marine Corps' liaison to the State Department, followed by a tour instructing midshipmen in the United States Constitution and leadership at the US Naval Academy.

She is a proven fighter who puts service before politics and does not back down from tough battles. Since 2020, Amy has helped Democrats win across the country, raising millions for candidates and defending democracy in key states. She also founded Honor Bound, Inc. a 501(c)(4) nonpartisan organization committed to leadership development for women with a service background and encouraging those women to run for elected office.

She is stepping up again to run for U.S. Senate because Kentucky deserves an independent voice who will fight for working families, not political insiders.
